NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Ham Lake, Minnesota (the "City"), will meet on Monday, April 4, 2016, at 6:01 p.m., at the City Hall, 15544 Central Avenue NE, Ham Lake, Minnesota for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the proposal that the City issue its revenue bonds (the "Bonds"), under the Minnesota Municipal Industrial Development Act, Minnesota Statutes, Sections 469.152 through 469.165, as amended (the "Act"), at the request of DaVinci Academy ABC, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation (the "Borrower"), for the purpose of financing the acquisition and construction of a school facility to be located at 532 Bunker Lake Boulevard, Ham Lake, Minnesota (the "Facilities"). The Facilities will be owned by the Borrower and leased to and operated by DaVinci Academy of Arts and Science, a public charter school sponsored by Friends of Education.

The Bonds will be special, limited obligations of the City, and the principal of and interest on the Bonds will be payable solely from the revenues pledged to the payment thereof. No holder of any Bonds will ever have the right to compel any exercise of the taxing powers of the City to pay the Bonds or the interest thereon, nor to enforce payment against any property of the City, except for the payments to be made by the Borrower to the City and pledged to the payment for the Bonds. The Bonds are

proposed to be issued in an amount not to exceed \$25,000,000.

The Bonds would provide (i) financing the acquisition, construction, and equipping of the Facilities; (ii) funding a debt service reserve fund; (iii) paying a portion of the interest on the Bonds; and (iv) paying a portion of the costs of issuing the Bonds (the "Project").

A draft copy of the proposed Application to the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development for approval of the Project, together with draft copies of all attachments and exhibits thereto, is available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk, located in the City Hall during normal business hours.

All persons interested may appear and be heard at the time and place set forth above, or may file written comments with the City Clerk prior to the date of the hearing set forth above.
