

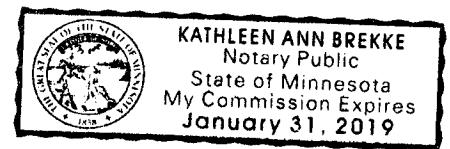

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING A

The City Council of the City of Ham Lake does hereby ordain as follows, pursuant to Chapter 9, Article 1050 of the Ham Lake City Code.

That the zoning classification for the following described property situated in the City of Ham Lake, Anoka County, Minnesota is hereby designated R-1 (Residential Single Family) (Hidden Forest East).

The land referred to herein is situated in the State of Minnesota, Anoka County described as follows:

The South Half of the Southeast Quarter, Section 25, Township 32, Range 23.

The East Half of the Southwest Quarter, Section 25, Township 32, Range 23.

The Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 25, Township 32, Range 23. EXCEPT Parcel 65, Anoka County Highway Right-of-Way Plat No. 81.
